## Progress/work schedule

Approval was given by the University in early October 2008 to spend £350K on a new outdoor facility to provide 3no All Weather Pitches, adjacent to the SportsPark, with the facility to be ready for October 2009

The initial Planning submission was refused in February 2009, a resubmitted Planning application was subsequently approved in late April 2009, following the addition of a noise survey and a parking survey to satisfy the requirements of Reading Borough Council

McArdle Sports-Tec were awarded the contract to build the All Weather Pitches via a two stage tender process and a series of associated interviews with 3No prospective specialist contractors

Following completion of the examinations in the adjacent SportsPark, McArdle Sports Tec stated work on the  $6^{th}$  July 2009 and the facility was completed by them on the  $25^{th}$  September 2009 ready for the opening on the  $1^{st}$  October 2009
