At this meeting we:

- Considered the top ranked potential Future Leaders Fellowship applicants and agreed on four proposals to develop more fully. Each candidate will be assigned two mentors an APVC and an academic specialist Additionally we have selected a candidate to put forward to the Leverhulme Award.
- Discussed a proposal to streamline our research governance structures. The next step is to capture a snapshot of committee activity and map out what is operationally feasible and where activity might be better served by task-and-finish groups, allowing committee time to be reduced.

In other news we:

• Talked about the Leadership Programme and considered other ways to take research leaders forward such as signposting, highlighting other opportunities and bringing in external people for specific development sessions.
