# **Bordeaux Wine Tasting**

#### Wednesday 23 October

A "Left Bank" vs "Right Bank" Bordeaux Wine Tasting.

The river Gironde and the two smaller rivers, Dordogne and Garonne, form a Y shape that separate Bordeaux in three main areas: the Left Bank is on the South, the Right Bank on the north and the area in between Dordogne and Garonne is known as Entre-Deux-Mers. The Left Bank and Right Bank are arguably the two main red wine regions in Bordeaux and have influenced the wine making styles and the consumer preferences around the world for a long time. In general, red Bordeaux wines are blended from Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Malbec, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot grapes. However, the vineyards in Left Bank are dominated by Cabernet Sauvignon, while those in the Right Bank focus on Merlot. Join us to explore a range of wines and vintages from each bank to find out your preferred style. All wines are selected from the SCR cellars and most are available in the SCR wine shop.
